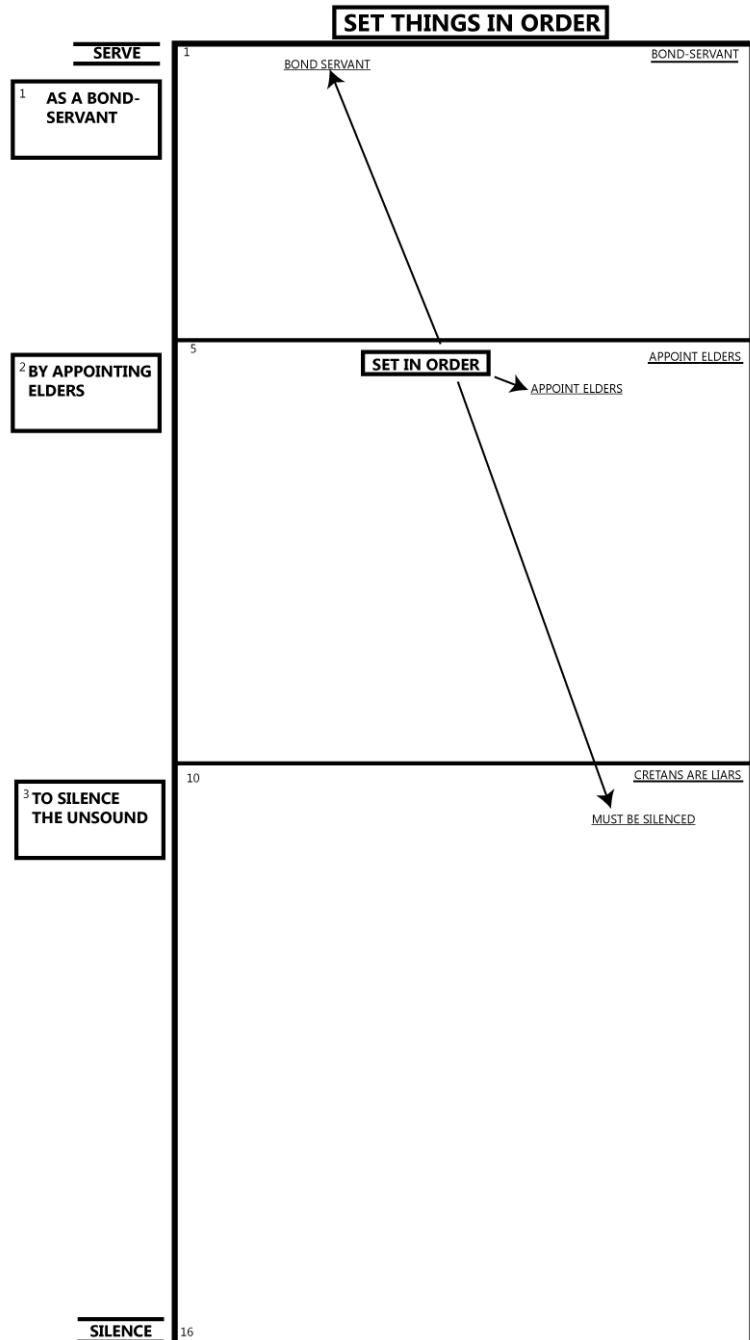

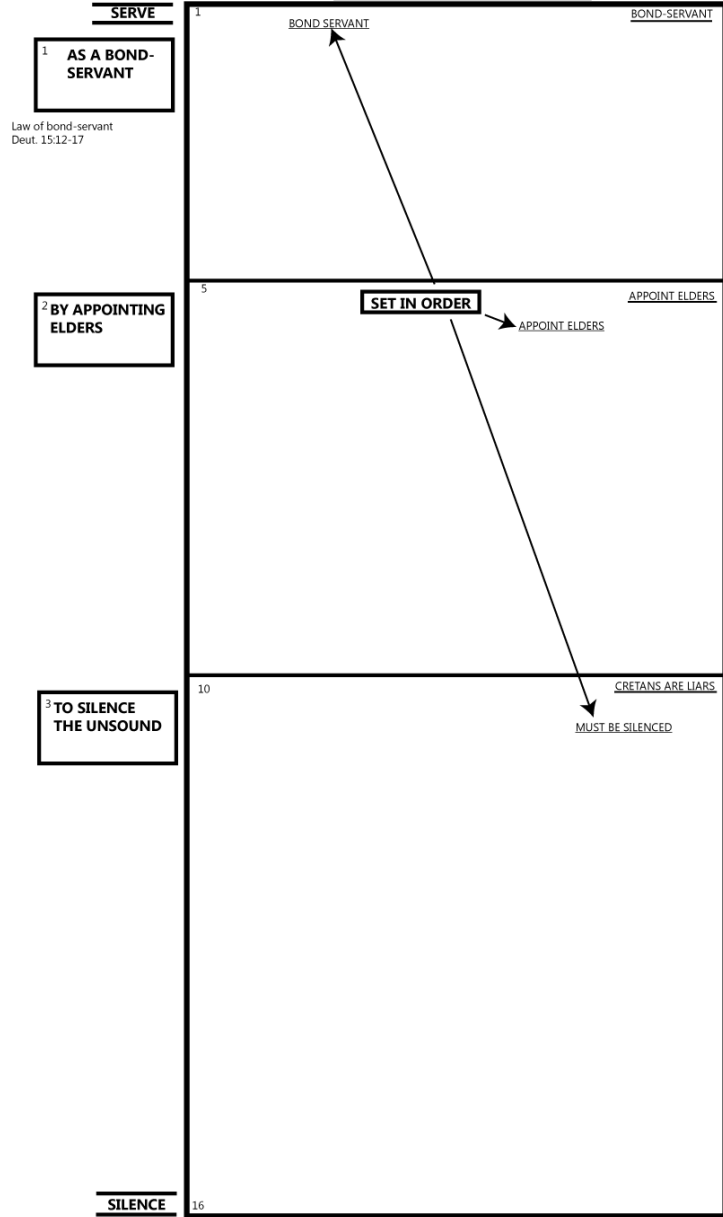

2 BY APPOINTING ELDERS

5 For this reason I left you, in Crete, that you would **SET IN ORDER** what remains and APPOINT ELDERS in every city as I directed you, *namely*, **any man** is... **above reproach**, the **husband** of one wife, having **children**...
...who believe
...not accused of dissipation
...or rebellion

For the **overseer** must be...**above reproach** as God's **steward**

NOT { self-willed, quick-tempered, addicted to wine, pugnacious, fond of sordid gain, **but** hospitable, loving what is good, sensible, just, devout, self-controlled, holding fast the faithful word which is in accordance with the teaching

so that he will be able both to **exhort** in sound doctrine and to **refute** those who contradict
